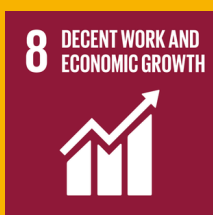
About Sarthak

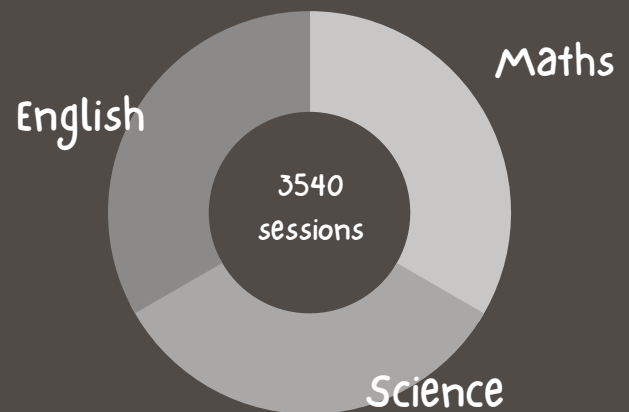

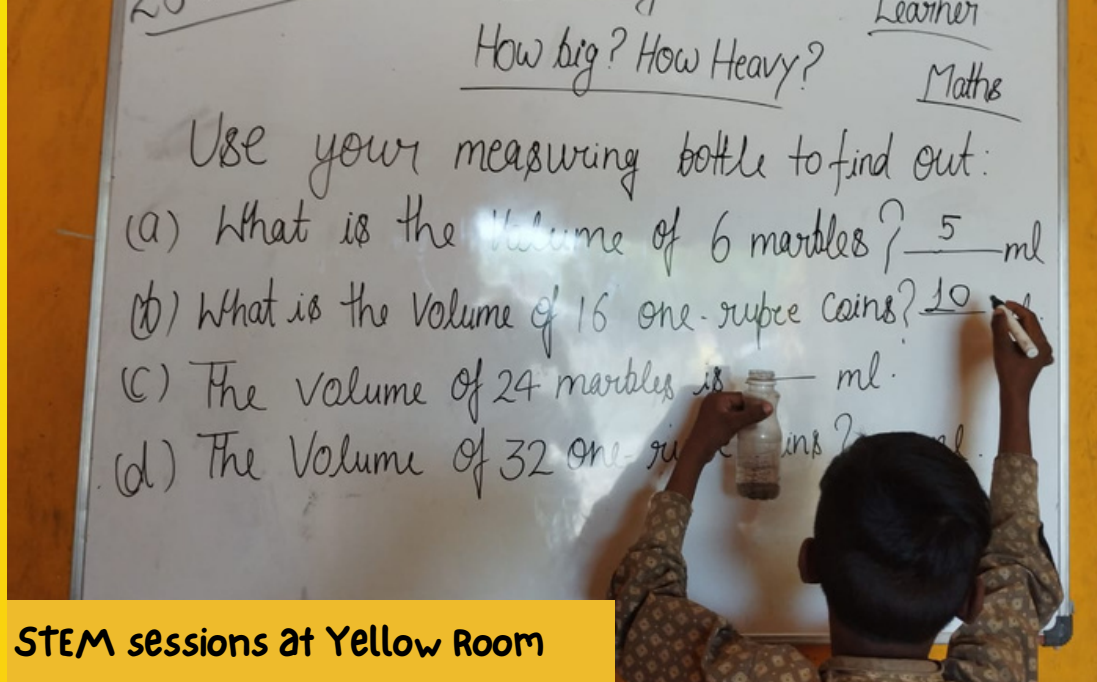

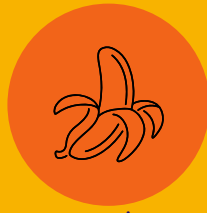

Gurukul is a model rural school that incorporates all the elements of a Sarthak Yellow Room into the formal school structure. The school offers marginalised children from poor rural backgrounds equitable, happy, gender-sensitive, well structured and digitally aided formal education at zero cost.

The school is attended by 480 children from 32 villages.

It proved to be a perfect forum to reflect upon the children's progress and connect with parents. They were very happy to see children evolve and grow admirably, especially in rural vicinity.

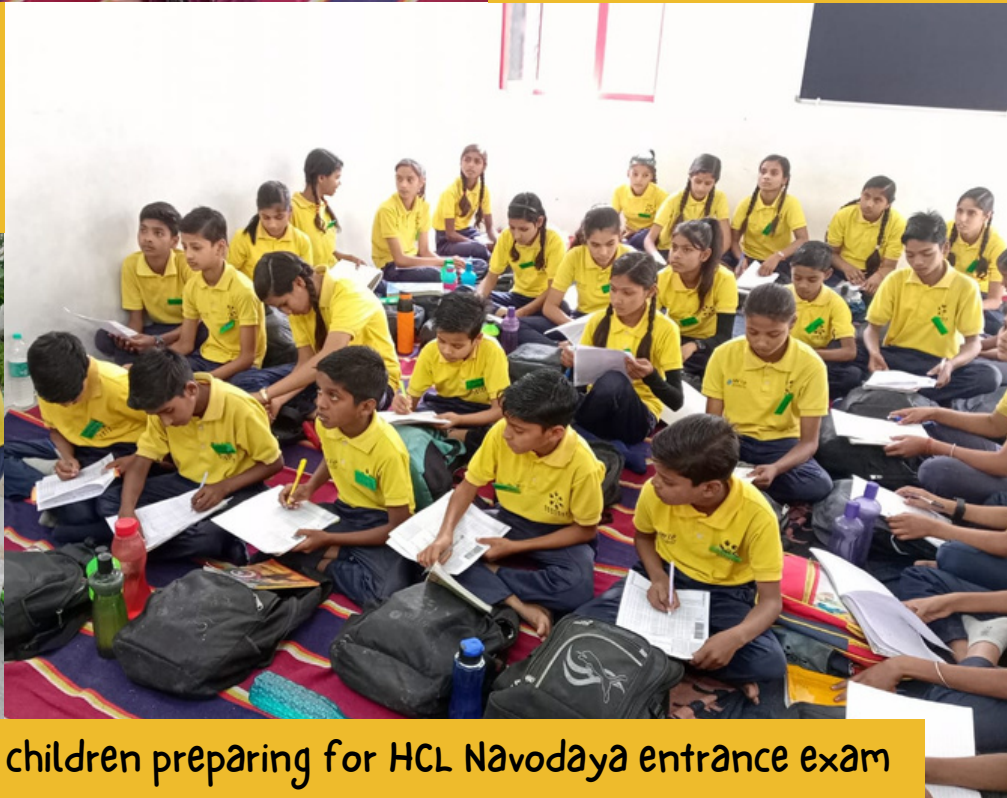
Gurukul has been able to nurture children with the right education and ethics and help them develop into well-rounded and sensitive individuals. Nearly, 300 parents attended PTM.

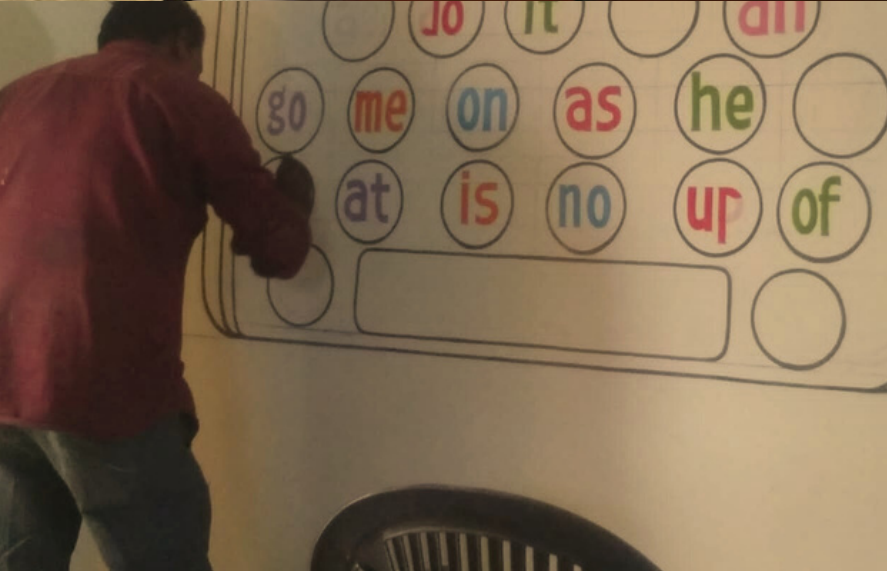
Yellow SLATES

Sarthak Yellow SLATES (Sciences, Languages, Arts, Theater and Ethics)

this year, we are bringing our Yellow Rooms model into the government school system of UP. we call this project - Yellow SLATES.

the aim is to improve upon children's foundational literacy & numeracy, digital literacy and communication skills/expressions/confidence while also imparting good moral values and improving their cultural awareness.

We are coming up with a custom curriculum called Naitik Shiksha that will use stories from Indian sources such as Jaatak Kathaein, Panchatantra, Hitopadesh and Amar Chitrakatha. we will deliver this using the medium of theatre and storytelling.



Like our Yellow Rooms, Yellow SLATEs is a long term intervention. It will function from inside a government school during school hours. First Yellow SLATE will be started soon at Government school Adarsh Nagar, Roza, Shahjahanpur, Uttar Pradesh.

Yellow SLATEs will reach out to 500-800 children per school.
